IMMIGRATION ACT 1971  
LETTER OF CONSENT

Forenames:

Dear Mr Cartens

You have applied for consent to the entry into the United Kingdom of the one person described in the margin of this letter. I am pleased to inform you that the Secretary of State has agreed to this. The entry of the person named will be facilitated if this letter is presented to an immigration officer on arrival at a United Kingdom port. The original must be presented and it is important that no alteration or amendment be made to it. A copy is not a valid entry clearance. In addition to this letter the person named will require a valid passport or travel document.

Sex:

Male

On arrival in the United Kingdom the immigration officer will probably ask some questions and there are circumstances in which he may refuse leave to enter, but if he takes this exceptional course the reason will be given and there will be an entitlement to appeal immediately to an independent adjudicator.

Nationality:

Chilean citizen

This letter is valid if presented to an immigration officer within six months of its date. If it is not required for any reason it should be returned to this office.
