I have been instructed to inform you that this Council recently adopted the following resolution:

"This Cities of London and Westminster Trades Council urges the T.U.C. to organise an immediate embargo of all goods to and from Chile, until the terror campaign ends, until all the political prisoners are released, and until democratic rights have been restored. In addition, we urge the T.U.C. to use all its influence with the I.C.F.T.U. to ensure that that body organises an international embargo to achieve these aims."
