THE ASSASINATION OF THE EXECUTIVE COLLITTEE OF THE LONGSHORE, THE OF THE PORT OF SAN ANTONIO

Another of the innumerable murders committed under the pretext of an alleged "attempt to flee" was that of six longshoremen officials of San Antonio. They were arrested under the pretext that they had incited a strike. According to military proclamation number 26, by Colonel Lanuel Contreras Sepulveda, and reprinted on page 2 of La Tercera, September 24th, they had attempted to flee during a breakdown of a truck that had been carrying them to the prison camp at Bulcalemu: all were killed. Their names: Fidel Alfonso bravo Alvarez, Haul Bacciarini Zorrila, Hector Rojo Alfaro, Samuel Nunez, Armando Jimenez Lachuca, Guillermo Alvarez Canas.
