> CHILE: Arrest of at least 20 people, mostly trade unionists

Amnesty International has learned that at least 12 of the trade union leaders arrested on 9 November 1984 during raids on their Santiago headquarters were subsequently relegado (sent to villages in remote parts of Chile for three months on the orders of the Minister of the Interior, without charge or trial, or right to appeal against their punishment). They were held incommunicado by the Central Nacional de Informaciones (CNI - Chilean secret police) for at least five days and then sent directly to their places of banishment. According to reports, relatives and lawyers were given no information about the detainees and their whereabouts until after they had been banished.
